Macomb Municipal Airport

A public-use, general aviation airport located 3 miles north and one east of Macomb, Illinois US Highway 67 or approximately 9 miles west of Bushnell and 3 miles south US Highway 67.

- Runways: one east/west hard surface runway 5,100 feet by 100 feet
 - one north/south grass runway 4,070 feet by 145 feet
- Facilities: Office/Terminal Complex with complete flight planning areas, pilot rest lounge, meeting room, Aviation Weather Observation System (AWOS) providing continuous monitoring of weather conditions and transmitting on frequency 119.02 or by telephone 309-837-4022.
